Nature of Complaint: Partial Lower Denture

Finding and Discipline: Violation of the Denturists Regulation regarding a partial lower denture. The Denturist's license did not provide for the fabrication of a partial lower denture.

Mr. Brian Akre consented to each of the following terms and/or conditions:

1. Pay a fine of \$1000 per partial denture fabricated.
2. A reprimand placed on his registration file for a period of three years.
3. Pay to the complainant, upon his request, any dental examination costs incurred in conjunction with the assessment of the partial denture and any balance of fees charged for, or in relation to, the partial denture.

Nature of Complaint: Advertising

Finding and Discipline: Violation of the College's bylaws. The registrant's full name did not appear in the advertising and use of the word "specializing" and other misleading words. Mr.

Brian Akre consented to each of the following terms and/or conditions:

1. The registrant undertakes:
 - a. To publish, at his expense, a public notice, approved by the committee, retracting the advertisements that listed the registrant's "specialities". The advertisement will list the services that an active registrant could have provided at the time of publication. The notice is to be published in local newspapers that service the same areas that had the offending advertisements. The notice is to be published at least once. If subsequent editions have not replaced any of the publications in which the offending advertisements appeared, then the notice must be published not less than once per month until one month after the new edition is published and distributed,
 - b. To submit, for approval by the Committee, any and all new advertisements for a period of one year, starting from the date this agreement is signed,
 - c. To admit to an error in professional judgment, and
 - d. Not to repeat the conduct.

2. The registrant consents to a reprimand being placed on his registration record. The reprimand will remain on the record for a period of three years. The reprimand is for the violations of sections 78(1), 78(5), and 78(9).
